

Venous Ulcer

PATIENT INFORMATION:

77-year old female

WOUND HISTORY:

Venous Ulcer present for over 8 months, continuing to enlarge in size despite wound care with modern dressings and treatment with a cellular tissue product.

DIMENSIONS:

Prior to SNAP™ Therapy, the wound measured 84mm x 45mm with a depth of 4mm without undermining.

COMORBIDITIES:

Diabetes Mellitus, Severe Peripheral Artery Disease, Smoker, COPD, Hypertension, Hyperlipidemia, Bone Cancer, Severe Malnutrition (weight <40kgs).

SNAP™ THERAPY TREATMENT:

The patient was treated with SNAP™ Therapy for 11 weeks until full granulation of the wound bed was achieved. Then SNAP™ Therapy was used in conjunction with a cellular tissue product for an additional 3 weeks.

OUTCOME:

Wound closure was achieved at 4 months post-initiation of SNAP™ Therapy.
